- 4.01 Purpose. To provide a guideline for the safety of the public and the Fire Department.

- 4.02 Goal. This guideline applies to all firefighters and apparatus while it/they are involved in parade activities.

- 4.03 Guidelines.
 - A) Audible warning devices, including sirens and air horns, are not to be sounded during the parade. (State Statute 346.03)

 - B) All firefighters are to be seated and belted during the parade.

 - C) No firefighter or member of the public sector shall ride on any part of the apparatus other than the seated areas.

 - D) No candy or other material shall be thrown from the apparatus.

 - E) Water shall not be sprayed from any portion of the apparatus.

 - F) All apparatus operators shall obey all traffic laws and be alert for pedestrians along the parade route.

 - G) Red warning lights may be used during the parade route and immediately shut-off upon the completion of the parade.
