- 8.01 Purpose. To provide a safe work environment for members of Township Fire Department.
- 8.02 Goal. Township Fire Department is committed to the health and safety of all of its members. This commitment is essential for conducting business in a responsible manner as to not endanger the well being of its members, community and environment.
- 8.03 The concept of risk management shall be utilized on the basis of the following principles.
- A) Activities that present a significant risk to the safety of its members shall be limited to situations where there is a potential to save endangered lives.
 - B) Activities that are routinely employed to protect property shall be recognized as inherent risks to the safety of its members, actions shall be taken to reduce or avoid these risks.
 - C) No risks to the safety of our members shall be acceptable when there is no possibility to save lives or property.
- 8.04 Involvement.
- A) Township Fire Department has the responsibility of assuring that the policy, procedures, and loss control principles are effectively communicated to all of its members.
 - B) All officers have the responsibility of maintaining a healthy, positive attitude towards safety in themselves and those they direct.
 - C) Member involvement is essential to a successful health and safety program.
