The Board of Directors of Township Fire Department, Inc., hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Township Fire Department, Inc. Board of Directors has adopted rates for reimbursement of its expenses in meeting hazardous materials spill, and

WHEREAS, that rate schedule has also been used in charging for reimbursement for certain other types of emergency calls, and

WHEREAS, the Township Fire Department, Inc. has had a policy of seeking reimbursement for certain types of emergency calls, but the Board of Directors has not yet formally adopted a rate schedule for those calls,

BE IT RESOLVED, that whenever any party causes a fire by reckless, intentional, or illegal conduct or omission, Township Fire Department, Inc. shall seek reimbursement of its costs incurred in said emergency response, pursuant to its rate schedule in effect at the time of the call. In the event that the responsible party or parties are juveniles, the Department shall seek reimbursement from their parents, guardians, or other responsible parties. In the event that the actual costs of the emergency call exceeds the rate schedule then in effect, the Township Fire Department, Inc. and or its insurer shall be entitled to seek the actual costs and damages incurred by the Department. The Township Fire Department reserves the right to seek any other damages it is entitled to from any entity covered by this Resolution.
