- 30.01 Purpose. This guideline will be implemented to assure a preplanned response to this particular target.
- 30.02 Goal. These guidelines will be used so that the Officer in Charge will know what the preplanned call up equipment will be. Any of this procedure may be changed at the discretion of the Officer in Charge.
- 30.03 Responding Units.
- A) The following units will respond to the scene of an active fire alarm at Silver Spring Gardens Hwy 37.
1. Engines 22, 31, 41,51.
 2. Tenders 16, 26, 36, 46, 56.
 3. Rescue 15, 25, 35, 45, 55.
 4. Brush 53.
- B) The following units will respond to the fill site.
1. P-400.
 2. P-500.
- C) The following Mutual Aid Units will be requested.
1. Rock Creek Tender.
- D) The following Departments shall be notified to standby.
1. Altoona.
 2. Mondovi.
 3. Chippewa Fire Protection District – Wheaton

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4. Elk Mound.

30.04 Due to the variety of products in the area, all personnel in the immediate vicinity of the fire will be in full turn out gear and will be wearing and using breathing apparatus unless otherwise designated by the Incident Commander or Safety Officer.

30.05 Miscellaneous Notes.

- A) Base has in their possession a list of key holders and their phone numbers for Silver Spring Gardens Hwy 37.
- B) There are two electric feeder services supplying power to the buildings. Xcel Energy is the electric provider.
