DRIVERS ROAD, PUMPING & SKILLS TEST**

It shall be understood that part of the requirements to drive TFD apparatus to emergency scenes, and to qualify for consideration of a pay increase from probationary pay rate to firefighter pay rate, the following Drivers Road, Pumping and Skills Test must be satisfactorily completed.

All drivers of motor vehicles for Township Fire Department, Inc. shall have a valid Wisconsin driver's license.

Recorded Drive Time Prior to Road Test

Prior to taking a Drivers Road test the member must have driven the apparatus wishing to be approved to drive at least five times at a duration of at least 10 minute in length with an approved station representative. The station representative must initial and date each time the apparatus was taken out.

Upon completion of the required pre-test driving time, the firefighter may request to complete the Driver's Road, Pumping and Skills test. Not all equipment needs to be checked off at one time. The test may be broken down over the course of several days. The increase in pay from the probationary rate to firefighter pay rate will not be done until all pieces of apparatus have been tested on.

Driver's Road, Pumping, and Skills Test

This driver's road, pumping and skills test will consist of sixteen (16) different objectives being tested or observed. A satisfactory in all sixteen (16) skills is required to pass.
